

HOLYHEAD – LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS 06/2024

2024 Spring Equinoctial Tides – Lowest Astronomical Tide (LAT)

Issued 12th February 2024 Expires 14th March 2024

Port users and other stakeholders are advised that Low Water on Monday 11th March will be the lowest tide in the 2008-2026 cycle of tides.

Low Water

The afternoon tide at 1704 on the 11th is predicted to be 0.0m, the lowest astronomical tide.

Mariners should be aware of what effect maneuvering at LAT may have on the handling characteristics of their vessel.

The evening tides two days before and two days after are also very low.

High Water

Morning High Waters are corresponding large and only 0.08m (8cm) off the Highest Astronomical Tide.

Port users and other stakeholders should be aware of the possibility of overtopping quay walls especially if high water is accompanied by adverse weather.

General

Tidal heights are predictions only and heights can be influenced by a range of factors including atmospheric pressure, prevailing weather, and swell conditions. It is therefore possible that lower and higher heights may be experienced.
